

# Rules & Regulations of the Transfer Station



**Per section 118-9** of the Town Refuse Law, **permits** are required to enter and all residents are required to recycle. Permits are available at the Town Hall, 24 Jordan Street or at the Transfer Station for a fee of **\$20.00 per Household**.

**Per Section** 118-5 All loads must be covered.

**Per Section** 118-6 Only Refuse that has originated from the Town of Skaneateles will be accepted.

**WARNING: Per section 118-11** Depositing refuse which has not originated in the Town of Skaneateles is punishable by a **\$250.00 fine and or 15 days imprisonment**.

**Per section** 118-9 Commercial Loads and Haulers require a Commercial Permit available at the Town Hall.

Place in compactor. Clear or White bags only.

**Deposit in designated bins:**

Florescent light bulbs  
Car Batteries  
Used Motor oil

**Recyclables:**  
**Single Stream Recycling-**  
**No Need To Separate**  
**DEPOSIT IN THE WHITE**  
**BUILDING**

**Paper Products:**

Newspaper, cardboard boxes (broken down)  
Magazines, catalogues, junk mail, office paper, phone books, non-corrugated cardboard, thin-paper

cardboard such as Cereal boxes, Kleenex boxes, pasta, boxes, pizza boxes, shoe boxes, food boxes, beer boxes, soda boxes, etc.

**Containers:**

Glass (food or drink in)  
Tin Cans  
Plastic Containers # 1, 2 and 5  
Examples: laundry detergent, shampoo, milk, and soda bottles.  
Gable top milk and juice containers.

**All of the recyclables have to be emptied from the trash bag that they are in and the bag needs to be thrown in the trash. Bags are NOT recyclable.**

See your local grocery stores for recycling your shopping bags.

**Swap Shop:**

Reusable items only.

**Wood Pile:**

This pile is for items made of lumber, which consists of: construction lumber, doors, windows, pallets, etc.

**\*NO COMMERCIAL LOADS\***  
**SMALL LOADS-Residents Only**

**Metal Pile Items:**

Washer/ Dryer/ Stove  
Lawn mowers, Bikes  
Lawn Chairs, Metal Pipes  
Gutters, Sheet Metal  
Hot Water Heaters  
Small/Large Kitchen Appliances  
Metal Windows, Pots & Pans  
Anything that is metal

**Brush / Composite Pile:**

This pile is for yard which consists of: Brush, Grass, Leaves, Flowers, Plants, Bushes, Christmas Trees, etc.

**Other Acceptable Items:**

Batteries  
Electronics  
Used cooking oil  
Used antifreeze  
**Tires-Residents Only \*LIMIT 4 tires per load; maximum 12 tires per year\***
