NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF OLD SENECA TURNPIKE WATER LINE CONTRACT NO. 1 WATER LINE UPGRADES TOWN OF SKANEATELES

Sealed bids for the construction of the Old Seneca Turnpike Water Line Contract No. 1 Water Line Upgrades will be received by the Town Clerk, Town of Skaneateles, Onondaga County, New York, at the Skaneateles Town Hall, 24 Jordan Street, Skaneateles, New York, 13152 until 10 a.m. local time, July 12th, 2017 and there at said office, at said time, publicly opened and read aloud.

This project provides for the construction of approximately 1,790 lineal feet of 8-inch DR-11 HDPE water line, approximately 460 lineal feet of 3/4 inch DR-11 HDPE services, and 3 fire hydrants and appurtenances to serve residents along Old Seneca Turnpike in the Town of Skaneateles.

The Contract Documents consisting of the Advertisement, Instruction to Bidders, Bid, Agreement, General Conditions, General Specifications and Contract Drawings may be obtained from C&S Engineers, Inc., 499 Col. Eileen Collins Boulevard, Syracuse, New York 13212. Contract documents will be provided electronically.

Copies of the above-described Contract Documents may be examined at no expense at the Offices of the Town Clerk, Town Hall, 24 Jordan Street, Skaneateles, New York, 13152; at the Community Development office, Onondaga County Community Development Division, 1100 Civic Center, 421 Montgomery Street, Syracuse, NY 13202, 435-3558; Syracuse Builder's Exchange, 6563 Ridings Rd., Syracuse, NY 13206; and at the office of C&S Engineers, Inc., 499 Col. Eileen Collins Blvd., Syracuse, New York 13212.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified or bank check or a bid bond payable to the Town of Skaneateles, in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the total bid as a guarantee that the Bidder will enter into the Contract if the project is awarded to said Bidder, and also in the form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders. If upon acceptance of said Bidder's Bid, a Bidder fails to enter into a Contract with the Town of Skaneateles, the certified or bank check or bid bond shall be forfeited to the Town of Skaneateles.

Bids must be submitted in sealed envelopes with the Project Name plainly written on the outside. No Bidder may withdraw his Bid within 45 days after the Bid Opening. The successful Bidder must furnish Performance and Payment Bonds, each in an amount at least equal to the Total Bid, with a surety authorized to do business in the State of New York and acceptable to the Town of Skaneateles.

Bidders are not to include in their Bid, sales and compensating use taxes of the State of New York and of counties or cities on materials, equipment, and supplies to be incorporated into the Project. Minimum Wage Rates shall be the higher of the two prevailing wage rates as determined by the New York State Department of Labor and the United States Department of Labor Davis-Bacon Act Determinations.

The General Municipal Law of the State of New York requires that Bidders certify, under penalty of perjury, that the Bids have been prepared without collusion with other Bidders, subcontractors, suppliers, etc. A certification is included with the Bid Proposal that each Bidder must sign in the space provided.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 11:00 A.M. local time on July 5th, 2017 at Town of Skaneateles Town Hall, 24 Jordan Street, Skaneateles, New York, 13152. Bidders are encouraged to visit the site prior to this conference.

The award of the Bid will be based on the following criteria:

- **If any bids for the Base Bid plus Add-On #1 come under the budgeted figure, the award will be made based on the Base Bid plus Add-On #1; however**
- **If any bids for the Base Bid plus Add-On #1 exceed the budgeted figure, the award will be made based on the Base Bid only.**

The Town of Skaneateles reserves the right to waive any informalities in the Bid and to reject any or all bids offered.
