**Present:** Supervisor Legg, Councilor Alexander, Councilor Tucker, Councilor Dove, Councilor Milne, Attorney Smith.

**Attorney Advice On** a motion of Councilor Dove, seconded by Councilor Milne and with unanimous (5-0) affirmation of the Town Board the meeting was adjourned to attorney advice at 5:00 p.m.

On a motion of Councilor Alexander, seconded by Councilor Tucker and with unanimous (5-0) affirmation of the Town Board the meeting returned to open session at 6:30 p.m.

**Eagle Scout Project Presentation – Kevin Torrissi:** Councilor Alexander introduced Kevin Torrissi. Kevin presented his proposed Eagle Scout project. He would like to build a safer and more structurally sound bridge to replace an existing bridge on the Guppy Falls Trail. He reviewed his plan to raise a bridge over the stream about 6-12 inches, and to build the bridge 10-12 feet long and 36 inches wide. Kevin is requesting the Town purchase the materials for the bridge.

Councilor Alexander showed pictures of the current bridge and pointed out the disrepair. She stated the Conservation Committee has a donor that would donate the funds for the material. She stated the Conservation Committee is in favor of this project and are excited about the proposed rebuilding of the bridge.

Councilor Alexander asked Kevin what his time frame would be for the project. He stated he would like to do the project in late August or early September.

On a motion of Councilor Alexander, seconded by Councilor Dove and with a (5-0) affirmation of the Town Board, the Board approved Kevin Torrissi's proposed bridge build project for the Guppy Fall trail bridge for his Eagle Scout project.

**Department Reports**

**Highway:** Highway Superintendent Dobrovosky stated he submitted his report to the Board for their review. He reported the Highway Department had done culvert pipe replacement on Gully Road, aided the Towns of Elbridge, and Sennett, did roadside mowing and weed eating, swept

intersections, took delivery of the new payloader, patched roads at water breaks on Jewett and Miller Roads and did repair work.

**Transfer Station:** Municipal Recycling Liaison Brian Buff was not present. Councilor Alexander reported the Transfer Station had sent out 13 loads of trash, 9 open top containers and 7 loads of recycling. She reviewed the cost and savings comparisons to date. \* Report attached.

**Planning and Zoning:** Planning and Zoning Secretary Karen Barkdull reported there were 9 new applications (report attached) for the Planning Board. She reviewed the open projects Menapace, Baxter, Foote and Lakelawn.

Other activities included 5 pre-application meetings, P&Z work session, meeting with Onondaga County Sherriff, Clerk I Aimie Case was trained on the IPS system, and she had completed 3 hours of training.

**Codes:** Codes Officer Herrmann reviewed the July Codes Office report. He reported they have 60 expired permits at this time. He thanked Sue and Jed Dove for the lake tour on their boat to view new construction on the lake.

He and Tim Dobrovosky attended the Onondaga County Hazard Mitigation meeting on July 23<sup>rd</sup>, and he is working on the report to submit back to the County. The Town Board will need to have a resolution on the final document.

**Parks:** Parks Manager Sue Murphy reported it has been a warm and busy summer. The lifeguards have done an excellent job at the waterfront. This is the time of year the Town starts to lose lifeguards; they start returning to college. August 20, 2024, will be the last day of swimming at Clift Park. Playday has been going well and it will end next week. The Farmers Market has been well attended. Ms. Murphy thanked Budget Officer Keri Fey for working with her to submit the grant paperwork for the Austin Park walking path. The County would be visiting the park to walk the new path. Baseball is wrapping up and they are starting to get ready for the Fireman's Field days.

Councilor Dove asked how the fences worked for Lakeshore Baseball. Ms. Murphy stated they had started off using the fences quite a bit in the beginning of the season but not as much as the season progressed.

Councilor Alexander stated the fences worked well and they were not as difficult to put up as Lakeshore coaches thought they would be. Some teams used them, and some teams did not. It was a successful season.

Supervisor Legg stated he had been at the park swim area and the boat launch and reported how busy the Parks Department is this time of year; it is a 7 day a week operation for Sue Murphy and her staff.

**Water:** Supervisor Legg reported the monthly coliform testing had been completed and came back from the lab with negative results and these results were submitted to the Department of Health. Water Foreman Shane Christman was on vacation.

**Engineer:** Supervisor Legg reported Town Engineer Miranda Robinson had left on maternity leave and the Board wished her well.

Supervisor Legg reported he would be working with C&S Engineer John Camp on the Andrews Road Water District and Water Tower Project. The agreement with the Cregg family for the site of the tower and pump station had been finalized. This agreement would allow the Town to do the soil boring and testing along with the tree removal for placement of the tank.

**Dog Control:** Councilor Milne reviewed the quarterly report submitted by Dog Control Officer, Dave Wawro. \*Report attached

**Budget:** Budget Officer Keri Fey reported they are preparing the packets for the department heads for the 2025 Budget. She would be scheduling budget meetings with the board at the August 19, 2024, Town Board meeting.

**Fire Department:** Councilor Dove reviewed the Skaneateles Fire Department June report. \*Report attached.

**Minutes of July 15, 2024:** On a motion of Councilor Tucker, seconded by Councilor Dove, and with a (5-0) affirmation of the Town Board, the minutes of July 15, 2024, were accepted as presented.

**Town Hall Renovations Bid Opening:** Supervisor Legg stated the Town Board had held another bid opening regarding the Town Hall Renovation Project.

Supervisor Legg and Clerk Stenger reported 8 different contractors were contacted and asked if they would be interested in bidding and only one bid was received. The project was originally put out to bid as one project which consisted of drainage/plumbing renovations, masonry/stone step

replacement, roofing and gutters, and new exterior siding. Since the bid for the project as a whole came in at a much higher cost than expected, the Board decided to split the project into four phases and have bids submitted separately for each phase.

- Phase 1        Masonry /Step Replacement
- Phase 2        Drainage and plumbing
- Phase 3        Roof and Gutters
- Phase 4        Exterior Siding

A bid opening for Phase I and II was held July 31, 2024, and one bid was received.

Codes Enforcement Officer Herrmann reviewed the bids as presented to the Board. He explained the prohibitive cost was due to the support beam in the front of the building needing to be replaced. With this large structural repair and the Town needed to comply with NYS Prevailing Wages it made the project more costly than anticipated. The foundation and beam work needed to be done before the front steps could be replaced. The plumbing and drainage are all tied into the basement and the drainage issues are affecting the structure of the building. These all need to be addressed before any cosmetic work can be done on the building.

Codes Officer Herrmann asked if this is the direction the Board wanted to go with the building? Councilor Alexander stated we need to fix the problems with the building and move forward.

Clerk Stenger stated we have the funds now to do Phase 1 and 2 and could budget over the next few years for phases 3 and 4.

Supervisor Legg and the Board was in agreement with moving forward with Phase 1 and 2. These phases are important to keep the structure of the building safe.

Councilor Alexander stated the Town had gone out to bid 3 times for this project and had done their due diligence to solicit bids. Attorney Smith stated yes, the Board had done the legal requirements, and they could accept the bid as presented if they chose.

On a motion of Councilor Alexander, seconded by Councilor Dove and with a (5-0) affirmation of the Town Board, the Board accepted bid from JMR Excavation for the Town Hall Renovation Project:

Phase 1	Masonry/Step Replacement	\$ 78,144.00

**Proposed Establishment of Village Meadows Drainage District:** Supervisor Legg stated the Board was in receipt of the map, plan and report from the applicant's engineer, Mike Lasall, for the Village Meadows Subdivision Drainage District.

Attorney Smith reviewed the probable cost of the annual maintenance over a 5-year and a 10-year period for the property owners.

1. The annual costs for overall vegetation inspection, sweeping and general maintenance are estimated at \$2,500.
2. Every 5-years for Vac truck of each CB is estimated at \$4,500
3. Every 10-years Cleaning Forebays and Dry Swales along with re-seeding disturbed area and underdrain flushing is estimated at \$12,500

Based on the anticipated costs above, the annual tax burden per parcel would be estimated at \$581.25 per lot for each of the 8 proposed lots. The construction of the drainage district would be incurred by the developer.

Supervisor Legg stated \$581.25 is well within the limits set by the New York State Comptroller. Attorney Smith agreed.

The Town Board approved the following resolution as presented:

**PROPOSED ESTABLISHMENT OF VILLAGE MEADOWS  
DRAINAGE DISTRICT.**

**WHEREAS**, at a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Skaneateles, New York held at 24 Jordan Street in the Town of Skaneateles, New York on August 5, 2024, the following resolution was offered by Board Member Councilor Alexander, who moved its adoption, seconded by Councilor Milne; and

**WHEREAS**, a map, plan, and report (the "Maps and Plans") has been filed with the Town Clerk in connection with the proposed establishment and improvement of a drainage district in the Town of Skaneateles (the "Town") to be known as Village Meadows Drainage District (the "District"); and

**WHEREAS**, the boundaries of the proposed District are set forth in the attached Schedule "A;" and

**WHEREAS**, the improvements proposed for the district include approximately 850 feet of gutters, twelve (12) catch basins, 800-LF of 12" SICPP stormwater pipe, 300-LF of 8" SCIPPP stormwater pipe, and three (3) dry swales (collectively, the "Improvements"); and



**WHEREAS**, the entirety of the costs to be expended for the construction of the Improvements shall entirely be borne by the applicant and at no expense to the District; and

**WHEREAS**, there will be no hook-up fees for properties in the District; and

**WHEREAS**, all future costs and expenses of operation, maintenance, and improvements, in said District, including all expenses related to all extensions of said District which may thereafter be established, shall be a charge against the entire area of said District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Maps and Plans describing the foregoing Improvements is on file in the Town Clerk's office and are available for public inspection during regular business hours.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED** that the Town Board will hold a public hearing at 24 Jordan Street in the Town of Skaneateles, New York to hear all persons interested in the establishment of the District on August 19, 2024, at 7:00 p.m.; and be it further

**RESOLVED AND ORDERED** that the Town Clerk shall give notice of such hearing by publishing a copy of this resolution in the Skaneateles Press, the official Town newspaper, and by posting a certified copy of this resolution on the Town's official sign-board, not less than ten nor more than twenty days before such hearing.

**Comp Alliance Revised Workers Compensation Plan Document:** Town Clerk Stenger reported that the Board was in receipt of a revised plan document from the Town of Skaneateles workers compensation insurance carrier, Comp Alliance. The revisions to the Plan Document were necessitated to make it consistent with recent changes in law applicable to public group insurers, such as the Town of Skaneateles.

On a motion of Councilor Milne, seconded by Councilor Dove and with a (5-0) affirmation of the Town Board, the Board authorized Supervisor Legg to sign the 2024 Comp Alliance Revised Plan Document as presented.

Councilor Dove left the meeting to attend a meeting at the Skaneateles Fire Department.

**Vehicles and Traffic Code 141-32. Schedule VII: Truck Exclusion Franklin Street, County Line Road:** Supervisor Legg reviewed the traffic issues on Town Roads in the Town of Skaneateles, especially concerning truck traffic at intersections. He referred to Franklin Street at the five corners, Masters Road, and Irish Roads off of Jordan Road.

Supervisor Legg reviewed the Town of Skaneateles Code chapter 141 section 13 and 32 which stated the Town Board is authorized to set weight limits up to 5000 pounds on any Town Road. This is an opportunity to restrict trucks to delivery and local traffic only on Town Roads. The Town of Sennett currently has a 5000-ton weight limit on their Town Roads off Franklin Street and Route 20.

Councilor Alexander stated there has been an increase in truck traffic recently and this could be caused by Google Maps sending trucks on these local routes.

Supervisor Legg stated that the Town has worked with traffic engineers with the Onondaga county DOT to change traffic on County and State roads. The County and State want to see what the Town has done to mitigate the problem. Having these weight limits on Town Roads would be a mitigation that the Town could put in place.

Supervisor Legg reviewed the process and mitigations that had taken place for the traffic light at the NYS intersection of State Route 321 and Old Seneca Turnpike. He stated it had taken almost 4 years to get the speed reduction on County Line Road south of Route 20 and the Town is still waiting for a response for the speed reduction on County line Road north of Route 20.

Supervisor Legg stated he would like the Board to consider changing the schedule in section 141-32 in the Town of Skaneateles Code to capture all the Town roads that attach to truck routes to mitigate trucks using these roads. Jordan Road is being reviewed now as a part of the Northern Hamlet Master Plan with Onondaga County.

From the audience, Mr. During asked who would enforce this regulation? Supervisor Legg answered the Town Board could authorize the truck exclusion and the 5-ton limit on Town roads. Once the process was complete with an introductory Local Law and public hearing the Board could approve the update to section 141-32 to exclude truck traffic and authorize a 5-ton weight limit on Town roads and the Local Law would be sent to the Onondaga County Sherriff's Department and NY State Troopers, and those departments would be able to enforce the law.

Supervisor Legg stated he would also have conversations with local businesses in the area. Exclusions would be for agriculture and local deliveries.

Supervisor Legg stated the Board is open to questions and comments regarding this proposed update to the Town Code section 141-32.

Mr. During asked about the 3-ton weight limit on the Crow Hill bridge, are local delivery vehicles allowed on the bridge and how is that determined. Supervisor Legg stated yes, only local deliveries.



**Stump Road and NYS Route 321 Intersection Request for Study:** Supervisor Legg announced the Board was in receipt of a petition from residents regarding the request for a study at the intersection of Stump Road and Route 321. This was received after an accident that occurred on July 31<sup>st</sup>.

The Board agreed that there had been numerous accidents at this intersection and agreed to forward the request to the New York State Department of Transportation and the Onondaga County Department of Transportation.

On a motion of Councilor Alexander, seconded by Councilor Tucker and with a (4-0) affirmation of the Town Board, the Board authorized the Town Clerk to submit the petition for a traffic study at the intersection of Stump Road and Route 321 to the New York State and Onondaga County Departments of Transportation.

### **Announcements/Correspondence/Updates**

*Conservation Area Tree Tags:* Councilor Alexander announced Janet Aaron and Greg McGee had been working on a project at the Guppy Falls Conservation Area. They had researched and made tags to identify the trees along the trail at Guppy Falls. Money had been donated by the Evans Family, Janet Aaron's family, for projects at Guppy Falls. The tags were installed and are a terrific addition to the trail.

*Northern Hamlet Plan Letters and Comments:* Supervisor Legg announced the public comment period for the Northern Hamlet Master Plan was closed. All the comments and letters received have been forwarded to EDR and the Hamlet Committee for their review.

*Parks Project Letters and Comments:* Supervisor Legg announced the public comment period for the Parks Project had closed and the Board is reviewing the comments and questions and would be making a public response.

*Letter in Support of Shotwell Brook Conservation Area Parks Grant Application:* Supervisor Legg announced a letter of support for the Shotwell Brook Conservation Area Parks Application Proposal was submitted to the Finger Lakes Land Trust.

*Letter in Support of WQIP Skaneateles Lake Watershed Application Proposal:* Supervisor Legg announced a letter of support for the WQIP Skaneateles Lake Watershed Application Proposal was submitted to the Finger Lakes Land Trust.

*Localized harmful algal bloom report (HAB) ([www.skaneateleslakeinfo.org](http://www.skaneateleslakeinfo.org)):* Supervisor Legg announced localized harmful algal blooms (HABs) had been identified in Skaneateles Lake. There have not been any large HABs and there have been no issues with the City of Syracuse and the water source. Information is available at [skaneateleslakeinfo.org](http://skaneateleslakeinfo.org).



**Public Comment:** Scott Brothers, Mottville Road, commented on the intersection at Route 321. He stated he had contacted the New York State DOT and stated the State will only look at the speed limit on the road and if the road would support the 55mph speed limit. If traffic is traveling at 55mph, the road could support it. He referred to the Town of Camillus and how they were able

to get the speed limit reduced on the portion of Route 321 that is in the Town of Camillus. He asked the NYS DOT for the procedure and wording the Town of Camillus used to help the Town of Skaneateles achieve the same.

On a motion of Councilor Alexander, seconded by Councilor Milne and with unanimous (4-0) affirmation of the Town Board the meeting was adjourned to attorney advice at 7:50 p.m.

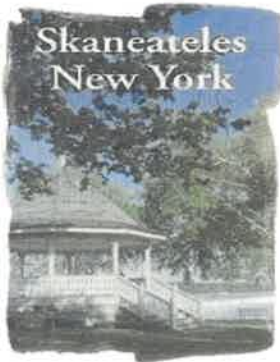


